Officers then observed an unknown individual acting suspiciously while walking away from the area. Officers made contact with the individual, who was later released from the scene.</p> <p>During the inventory of the cart, officers found an item labeled with a last name. Through further investigation, they were able to locate the owner of the item. After speaking with the owner, it was determined that their home had been burglarized and the items had been stolen.</p> <p>An investigation is underway to determine whether the individual seen near the shopping cart is connected to the burglary.</p>

The driver was detained while an investigation was conducted. Upon investigation, the suspect had several tools located in his pockets, various key fobs and a frequency jammer. Officers were able to make contact with the owner of the stolen vehicle who confirmed they did not give the driver permission to use the vehicle. It was discovered that an unknown suspect took an item from the victim's residence without consent.</p> <p>A thorough investigation, aided by residential security cameras and the Virtual Gate system, a suspect's vehicle was identified.</p> <p>Officers were able to track the vehicle's movements into the Memorial Village area. The Memorial Village Police Department located and stopped the vehicle, and West U officers responded to the scene.</p> <p>The driver, Mariela Reyes, was found to have an active warrant and was taken into custody. The passenger, Tania Lisbeth Medrano Mentzguen, was detained for an immigration violation and transported to the West University Place Jail for further investigation. Both individuals admitted to taking packages from residential porches in West U over the weekend and were actively attempting to steal more at the time of the traffic stop. Both the driver and passenger were charged with theft, and the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement Agency placed an immigration hold on both individuals. Reports 25-</p>
