HOW TO APPLY

To apply for a free tree from the West University Place Trust, just fill out the application and return it to the City. You can fax it to 713-662-5304, drop it off at City Hall or the Public Works Building or you can seal this brochure and drop it in the mail. It's that easy!

If you are approved you will receive a 30-gallon tree, which is approximately 10 feet tall and 2" in caliper. Should you desire a larger tree, you will have to pay the difference in cost.
