COVID-19 Local Weekly Update – November 13, 2020

- Staff is continuing to monitor the growth of the 3rd wave of COVID cases in Texas with daily new
 cases above 10,000 per day which is similar to what Texas experienced in the 2nd wave that
 peaked in July; however hospitalizations in our region have only increased moderately due to
 mean age of new cases decreasing by about 10 years.
- The COVID Hospital Census for Trauma Service Area Q is at 6.59% which is up slightly from last week but still well below the state's 15% threshold.
