



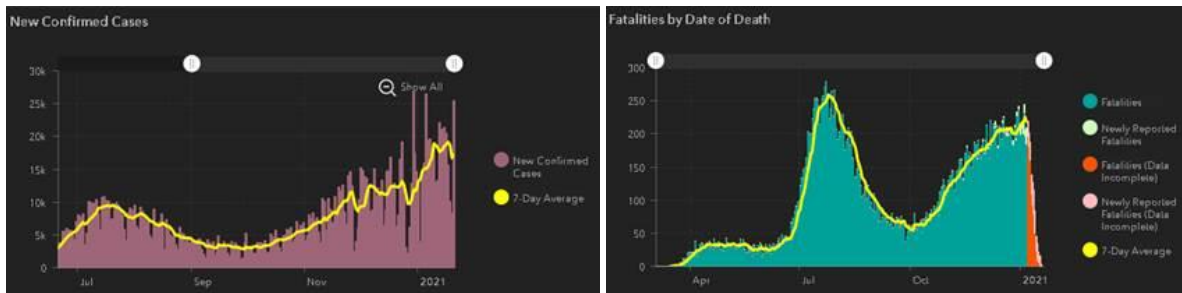

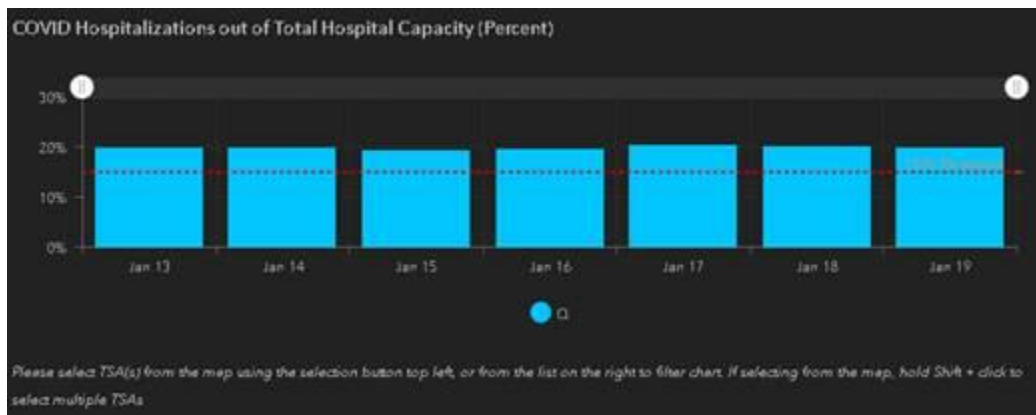

COVID-19 Local Weekly Update – January 21, 2021

- In Texas 25,512 new cases were reported on 01/20/2021 which is yet another near record number of cases for the state.



- COVID Hospitalizations for TSA Q is at 19.71% as of 01/20/2021. TSA-Q, which includes Harris County, now has restrictions that limit restaurant occupancy to 50% and forces bars to close. These restrictions will be in place until the percentage falls back below the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



- Harris County Public Health data indicates West University to have 454 total “Confirmed Cases”, 118 “Active Cases”, 336 “Recovered Cases” and Zero “Deaths”.
- Positivity Rates: Texas- 16.61% , Harris County- 19.4%, TMC- 12.7%
- TMC is reporting the ICU’s to have exceeded Phase 1 configuration and are at 89% of the combined Phase 1 and Phase 2 capacities.
